

# Informal discussions on criteria defining an “Evaluation Project”

## Perspectives from the NEA secretariat

WPEC members are defined explicitly in the mandate

*“Representatives of the co-operating nuclear data projects”*

*“The Working Party will consist of up to five representatives of [...] ENDF [...] JEFF [...] JENDL [...] ROSFOND/BROND [...] CENDL [...] IAEA [...] At least one member of each group will be a representative of the nuclear data measurement community, and another one a representative of the nuclear application community”*

However there is no definition of a nuclear data evaluation project.

## Informal criteria for discussion

Participating Nuclear Data Evaluation Projects should fulfil the following requirements:

- Established for a few years
- Governing board/committee planning future developments
- Complete usable library (General and Special Purpose files)
- Contain original work in the GP file (i.e. a number of new evaluations)
- Cover also the field(s) of ND measurements and/or ND validation
- Respond to the needs of end-users for specific application(s)
  
- Other requirements?
