

Summary Report of WPEC Subgroup-B on activities in 2004

Several of the main evaluation projects are about to release new versions of their libraries. It seems that the formatting problems have been resolved, and emphasis has shifted to data processing and validation.

No new format proposals were formally received. During the testing phase of JEFF-3.1, some processing problems were encountered. For examples, in some files adopted from JENDL-3.3, interpolation law INT=22 was specified for data in MF5, which is administratively forbidden. Before requesting patches to the processing codes, formal approval of the format extension should be sought. There may exist other similar examples.

A co-ordinated review of collected patches for the NJOY System would be desirable.

My Service at the IAEA will be coming to an end. For practical reasons it might be useful for WPEC to consider appointing a new person to co-ordinate Subgroup-B.
