Obtaining a Visa

If it is necessary for you to obtain a Visa to attend this Workshop held in Spain on the Spanish Embassy or consular section in your country.

Apply for your Visa well in advance of your travel! Important steps to remember:

- Review your Visa status and find out if you need a Visa for Spain or a renewal.
- Review the Visa wait times information for interview appointments and Visa processing at each embassy and consular section worldwide. Visit the embassy or consular section website where you will apply for your visa to find out how to schedule an interview appointment, pay fees and any other instructions.

Letter of Invitation

If you require a letter of invitation from the CSN for your Visa application, please register as soon as possible and ensure that the following information is included in your participant registration:

- Your full name (Family name and given name, as it appears on your passport)
- Degree (M.D., Ph.D, etc.)
- Job Title (Professor, Lab Director, etc.)
- Organization
- Full mailing address

Additionally, once your registration is completed, send an email to the NEA Secretariat: yuji.kumagai@oecd-nea.org with copy to Stephanie.RUIZ@oecd-nea.org requesting a letter of invitation, providing the aforementioned information, which will be then forwarded to the hosting organization, along with your contact details, in order to issue the letter of invitation. You will receive the signed invitation letter in pdf format.

Note: The Spain Visa application process can take several months. We strongly encourage travellers to register for the Workshop and apply for their Visas as early as possible.
