The data and other information related to the BWR-based (BW-SMR) cases based on the BWRX-300 configuration are released under the following conditions:

1. The data and information is exclusively released to participants in the LW-SMR benchmark study.
2. Recipients agree to use the released data and information only for the purpose of the LW-SMR Benchmark Study
3. Recipients agree not to make copies of the information and not to further distribute or sell it to third parties.
4. Participants agree to acknowledge the funding support of the benchmark by the North Carolina (NC) Collaboratory.
5. Participants of the benchmark agree to acknowledge the support of the benchmark by the North Carolina State University (NC State) and General Electric Vernova Hitachi (GEVH).
